Experience contemporary and historical China in our fully immersive 10-day educational tour program. Students will experience the modern wonders of Shanghai and Beijing technological advancement, balanced with guided tours of key historical sites and ancient wonders. Students will be able to practice first hand their language skills through accessing public transport, visiting historic site and museums.

Highlights include the stunning Terracotta Warriors of Xian, the glorious palaces and gardens of the Forbidden City and Summer Palace, the local Hutong area of Beijing and its laneways, businesses and museums and walking on the Great Wall of China.

Students will increase their understanding of and respect for Chinese history and culture.

- Visit the Summer Palace, with its ornamental gardens, lake and characteristic pavilions and take a cruise.
- Leisure time at teacher's discretion.

DAY 4: BEIJING

- Visit the Great Wall, Mutianyu Section.
- Rest up before tonight's dinner and entertainment, presented by the Shaolin Monks' Kung Fu show.

DAY 5: BEIJING – XIAN

- Transfer to the station for your bullet train to Xian.
- Visit the Wild Goose Pagoda and nearby Muslim market street for some souvenir shopping.
- Return to your hotel and check in before dinner this evening – a dumpling banquet.

DAY 6: XIAN – SHANGHAI

- Board your private coach to visit Xian's Terracotta Warriors and Horses with your guide.
- Visit the impressive Xian City Wall where students can bike ride along the City Wall (helmets included).
- Transfer to the airport for your flight to Shanghai.

DAY 7: SHANGHAI

- Visit the Shanghai World Financial Centre with your guide and enjoy the view from the observation deck.

- After lunch visit the impressive Shanghai Science and Technology Museum and wander around the many interesting exhibits.

Immerse yourself in French culture by travelling the way the locals do. The first 5 days of this 11-day tour are based in prestigious accommodation in the bustling 14th arrondissement of Paris, where there is plenty of time to experience the sites of this wonderful city. Students will then travel to the stunning Loire Valley where they will visit Chenonceau castle, Amboise castle and Clos Lucé castle, the last residence of Leonardo da Vinci.

Aimed at secondary school French language students, this tour will improve language skills, and assist students to better understand and gain more respect for other cultures. Students will also gain confidence and improve team bonding. This program has been designed for the experienced French teacher and small groups. Recommended extension options include a language and homestay in Rouen or Montpellier – see below for more details.

INCLUSIONS

Language and Homestay in Rouen

Teachers engage the students in a variety of activities aimed at improving all aspects of their French, with a particular focus on speaking skills. French in Normandy is a fully accredited government language school located in the heart of Rouen, capital of the beautiful and historic region of Normandy, just 1 hour west of Paris. Students will participate in language lessons in the morning and cultural activities in the afternoon. Homestay options also available.

Language and Homestay in Montpellier

This 5 day program will give students the chance to immerse themselves completely in the language and culture of Southern

France with a fantastic homestay experience in Montpellier. Each morning the students will have breakfast with their host families and then make their way to the language school where they will begin their day with a 3-hour French class. Following the morning lessons, the afternoons are spent enjoying various cultural activities. A guided walk of Montpellier, as well as a half-day excursion to Nimes and the Pont du Gard is included in the package. Additional cultural excursions to Avignon and Arles can also be arranged upon request. At the end of each afternoon the students will return to their host families where they will have a chance to talk about their day and share dinner with their family. The language school will provide lunch each day.

Students will get the chance to experience what daily life is like for families in the south of France and improve their French through their daily interactions with their host family, complimented by 15 hours of French lessons at our highly regarded French language school in Montpellier.

INCLUSIONS

Flights:

- Return economy class airfares including prepaid taxes, levies and charges.

Accommodation/Meals:

- 7 nights accommodation with breakfast and dinner daily.

- Following breakfast at your accommodation, you will be taken on a city sights tour by coach.
- In the afternoon, continue exploring Paris.

DAY 4: PARIS – VERSAILLES – LOIRE VALLEY

- Depart by coach and begin your tour of the French countryside.
- Stop at Chateau de Versailles, continue by coach to Chartres where you will visit Chartres Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Travel to your hotel accommodation in Tours.

DAY 5: LOIRE VALLEY

- Meet your coach and guide for a full-day tour of the Loire Valley castles.

DAY 6: LOIRE VALLEY – LIMOGES

- Travel south via Poitiers and the village ruins of Oradour-sur-Glane.

- Today, enjoy your third French lessons.

Many Australian schools have sister schools in Japan and we can facilitate these stays around an educationally based itinerary.

DAY 1: AUSTRALIA – TOKYO

- Fly to Tokyo.

DAY 2: TOKYO

- Meet and Greet on arrival.
- Travel by train to central Tokyo and make way to your accommodation.
- Remainder of the day is free to explore Tokyo under teacher's guidance.

SUGGESTION: Visit Sensoji Temple and Nakamise shopping street, Tokyo Skytree.

DAY 3: TOKYO – DISNEYLAND

- Make your way to Maihama station and spend a fun filled day at Disneyland.

DAY 4: TOKYO – KYOTO

- Explore Tokyo under teacher's guidance in the morning.
- SUGGESTION:** Visit Meiji Shrine, Takeshita Dori, a street lined with fast food outlets and fashion boutique, Shibuya crossing.
 - Travel to Kyoto by train.
 - Remainder of the day to explore Kyoto under teacher's guidance.

SUGGESTION: Visit Gion, well known as Geisha district. The streets of Gion are characterised by olden wooden townhouses (machiya) which contains teahouses (ochaya), shops and restaurants. Enjoy a traditional Japanese performing art show at Yasaka Hall Gion Corner.

DAY 5: KYOTO

- Explore Kyoto under teacher's guidance.
- SUGGESTION:** Visit Nijo Castle, Kinkakuji Temple, Kyoto Imperial Palace and Kiyomizudera Temple.

DAY 6: KYOTO

- Explore Kyoto and surrounds under teacher's guidance.
- SUGGESTION:** Travel to Nara, visit Kofukuji and Todaiji Temples. On your way to Nara you can also visit Fushimi Inari Shrine.

DAY 7: KYOTO – HIROSHIMA

- Travel to Hiroshima by train.
- Remainder of the day it free to visit the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park & Museum, the A-Bomb Dome and the Children's Peace Monument under teacher's guidance.

DAY 8: HIROSHIMA – OSAKA

- Explore Hiroshima and surrounds under teacher's guidance.
- SUGGESTION:** Travel to Miyajima Island, famous for its Torii Gate. Visit Itsukushima Shrine, stroll through the market or enjoy a cable car ride up to Mt Misen.
 - Travel to Osaka by train.
 - Remainder of the day to explore Osaka under teacher's guidance.

SUGGESTION: Visit Dotonburi, popular shopping and entertainment district and is also known as a food destination.

DAY 9: OSAKA – AUSTRALIA

- Explore Osaka and surrounds under teacher's guidance in the morning.
- SUGGESTION:** Visit Osaka Castle, Aquarium or travel to Himeji to visit Himeji Castle.
 - Travel by train to Kansai airport.
 - Depart for Australia.

Located a short distance to Kyoto, the Ayabe homestay experience is a cross-curricular experience for both language and culture. Students experience life with a Japanese family and participate in cultural, educational and leisure activities with local school children in Ayabe.

The school exchange programme will provide a truly immersive language experience in a safe environment.

INCLUSIONS

Flights:

- Return economy class airfares including prepaid taxes, levies and charges.

Accommodation/Meals:

- 6 nights hotel accommodation with breakfast.
- 3 nights homestay with breakfast daily, 3 lunches and 3 dinners (students).
- 3 nights hotel accommodation in Ayabe with breakfast daily and 3 lunches (teachers).

Meet and Greet on arrival

Transfers/Transport/Entrances/Activities:

- Airport shuttle to hotel.
- Private coach transfer from hotel to Ayabe.
- 7 days ordinary Japan rail pass.

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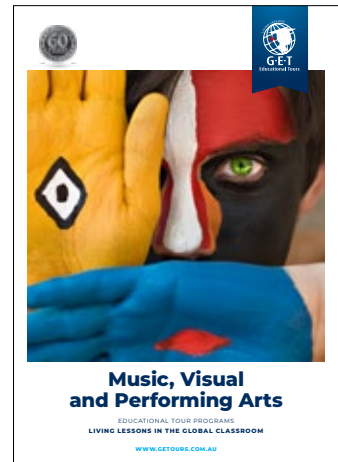
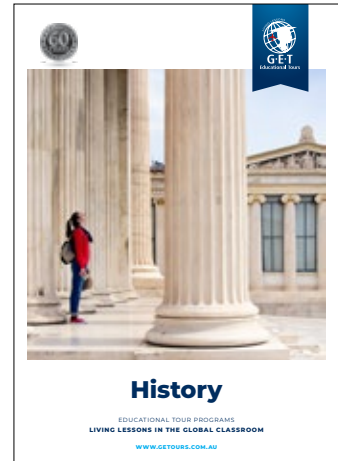
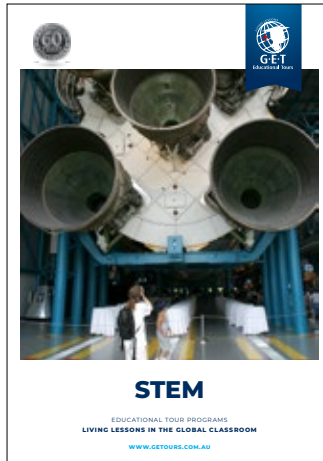
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
