Opening with a cruise on the Rhine, then onto Berlin, Cologne, Dresden, and ending in Munich, students will experience German culture from bustling Berlin to quiet rural towns, from modern art and architecture to war ruins and ancient castles.

- Depart for Dachau, the site of the first German concentration camp.

Modern History

Experience modern war history brought to startling life in this definitive tour of world war sites in Europe. This 14-day tour begins in Nürnberg with its Nazi Rally grounds and the court rooms of the Nürnberg trails. German tour highlights include the Documentation Obersalzberg, a museum of National Socialism in Berchtesgaden and the Dachau Memorial. Students move into Belgium and visit the Belgium battlefields. Continue to the Somme and finish in Paris with a focus on the occupation. Alongside the formal itinerary, there are plenty of opportunities for students to explore other fascinating sites and experience local food, art and customs

Highlights of Vietnam

Modern History

This program highlights both historical and contemporary Vietnam and is suitable for secondary school students, who will gain a better understanding and respect for other cultures. Southern Vietnam is a place of fascinating contradictions; thriving metropolis and peaceful rural lands, colonial and Asian influence in food and architecture, and a creative and artistic people living with the scars of a devastating war. Students on this 9-day tour will experience these contradictions for themselves as they travel from Saigon to the Mekong Delta, and onto the lovely port town of Hoi An. Highlights of this tour include a visit to the incredible Cu Chi tunnels built and occupied by the Vietcong, the stunning 12th century ruins of My Son, and a Vietnamese cooking lesson.

- Visit Thien Mu Pagoda and the Mausoleum of former Emperor Minh Mang.

- Continue to the elaborate Mausoleums of Emperors Tu Duc and Khai Dinh.

DAY 5: HUE - HOI AN

- Travel south to Danang through the inspiring 4900 ft high Hai Van Pass.
- Stop at the stone-carving village at the foot of the Marble Mountains.
- Continue to the town of Hoi An and transfer to hotel.
- Rest of the day at leisure at teacher's discretion.

DAY 6: HOI AN - MY SON- HOI AN

• Travel 40 kms southwest of Hoi An to visit the My Son ruins. Visit a family-run lantern-making business, where you will get a chance to design your own lantern with the assistance of your Vietnamese hosts.

DAY 7: HOI AN

- Cooking lesson at the Red Bridge (Cau Do) restaurant by the river.
 Participate in buying ingredients at the local market, before a quick boat trip on the Hoi An River to the cooking school. Enjoy the dishes you cooked for lunch.
- Rest of the day at leisure at teacher's discretion.

- Afternoon at leisure at teacher's discretion.

SUGGESTION: visit the Tet Offensive building and Ho Chi Min City Art Gallery.

DAY 8: HO CHI MINH CITY -SIEM REAP

- Transfer to the airport for your morning flight to Siem Reap.
- Visit the Cambodian Landmine Museum and Banteay Srei.

DAY 9: SIEM REAP

- Visit the Killing Fields in Wat Thmey and the Angkor National Museum with your guide.
- Visit to Angkor Wat at sunset.

DAY 10: SIEM REAP -PHNOM PENH

- Transfer to the airport and flight to Phnom Penh.
- Visit to the Bophana Centre, Tuol Sieng and the Killing Fields.

DAY 11: PHNOM PENH

• Fly to Ho Chi Minh City and depart for Australia.

Tahune AirWalk (90m from Hobart)

The Tahune AirWalk is an exhilarating, nature-based experience, set in the world-renowned Tahune Forest Reserve. The AirWalk is an elevated walkway that extends for 597m through the forest, providing a unique bird's-eye view of the tree species and forest life. Half and full day educational programs available.

Hollybank Treetop Adventure (Launceston)

Feel the adrenalin rush of a high-wire canopy ride as you fly above the treetops and Pipers River, along almost a kilometre of cable, on a guided zipline tour. The journey includes cable spans of between 15 and 400 metres, connected by tree platforms called 'cloud stations'. Led by knowledgeable and highly trained guides, you will get an informative and entertaining outlook on the beautiful forest.


