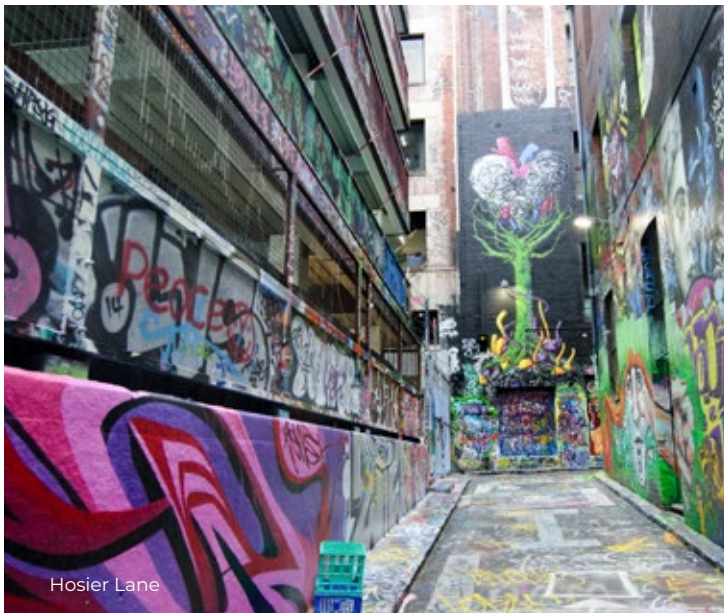

The Visual Art opportunities within Europe to both view and study are endless. Students will be exposed to some of the world's most iconic museums such as the Vatican Museum, Uffizi Gallery, Accademia, Barcelona Museum of Contemporary Art, Musée Picasso, The Louvre, Musée D'Orsay etc. Students will expand their knowledge and appreciation for the art of the Renaissance period in particular, which transformed the art world in Europe.

- Travel on the RER train to Versailles.
- Meet your guide and commence your guided tour of the Palace.
- Remainder of the day as leisure time at your teacher's discretion.

DAY 4: PARIS – VERSAILLES – PARIS

- Explore the museums and galleries of Paris at teacher's discretion.

DAY 5: PARIS – BARCELONA

- Board your private coach for Auvers and Giverny.
- Visit the Vincent Van Gough's house in Auvers.
- Then travel to Paris airport for your afternoon flight to Barcelona.

DAY 6: BARCELONA

- Meet your local guide and visit some of Barcelona's most famous sites including La Sagrada Familia and Museo Picasso.

- Meet your guide after breakfast and travel by private coach to the MACBA and Foundation Miro, before proceeding to the Park Guell.

DAY 1: AUSTRALIA – TOKYO

- Fly from Australia to Tokyo on an overnight flight.

DAY 2: TOKYO

- Meet and greet on arrival and private coach transfer to your hotel.
- Remainder of the day is free to explore Tokyo under teacher's guidance.

SUGGESTION: Visit Sensoji Temple & Nakamise shopping street and Tokyo Skytree. You may also like to visit Akihabara also known as 'Electric City'.

DAY 3: TOKYO

- Today is free to explore Tokyo under teacher's guidance.

SUGGESTION: Visit Meiji Shrine, Takeshita Dori, a street lined with fast food outlets and fashion boutique, Shibuya crossing, Edo Tokyo Museum, Disneyland.

DAY 4: TOKYO – MATSUMOTO

- Use your rail pass to travel to Matsumoto. On arrival, meet your co-ordinator at the station and walk to your hotel.
- Participate in a soba making workshop and enjoy your creation for lunch.
- After lunch, catch a local bus from Matsumoto city office, travel to Museum of Art to enjoy Yayoi Kusama Special Exhibition (entrance not included).
- Take a bus and travel to Suzuki Method HQ. Enjoy a welcome performance by local students.

DAY 5: MATSUMOTO

- Walk to Matsumoto castle and enjoy a guided tour. Walk along Nawate and Nakamachi street, a car free zone lined with small eateries and quirky shops.
- Catch a local bus and travel to local school. Enjoy cultural exchange and sport club activities.

DAY 6: MATSUMOTO – KYOTO

- Walk to Suzuki Method concert hall. Enjoy a musical performance by local students.
- Travel to Kyoto.

DAY 7: KYOTO

- Today visit a local high school for a cultural and music exchange.
- In the evening, enjoy a traditional Japanese performing art show at Gion corner.

DAY 8: KYOTO

- Today is free to explore Kyoto under teacher's guidance.

SUGGESTION: Visit Nijo Castle, Kinkakuji Temple, Kyoto Imperial Palace and Kiyomizudera Temple.

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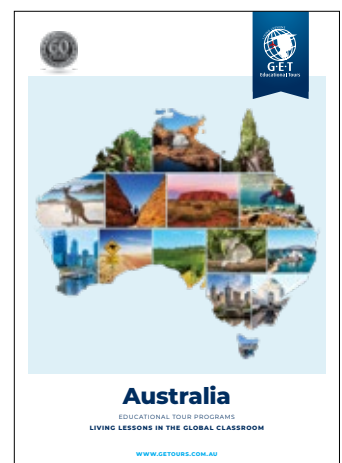
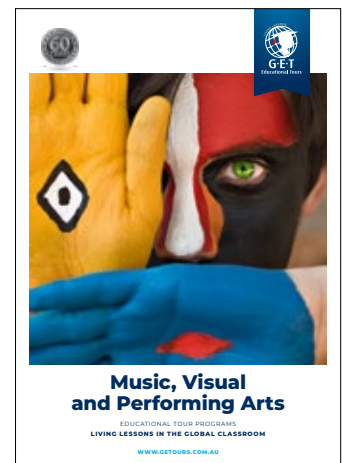
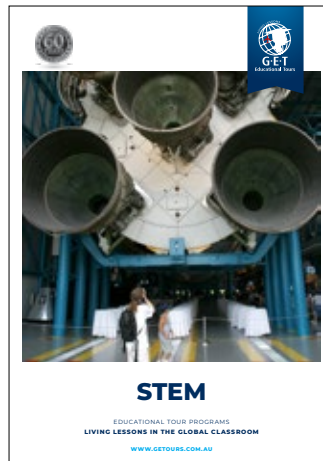
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
